Due Date

All dues payments are due by **February 1**, either post-marked or hand-delivered.

Late Fees

Payments received after February 1 will incur a late fee of \$10 per week. If you make your dues payment after the deadline, you should include the late fee, with each portion of a week considered a whole week.

Suspension

Members who do not pay their dues or late fees will have their license suspended. On March 1, members will be given notice that on approximately April 1, a petition will be filed with the supreme court requesting that the members who have not paid their bar dues or late fees will have their license suspended. (See Alaska Bar Rule 61.)

Substantive Law Sections

Membership is open to all members in good standing. Members must renew their section membership each year. Section membership runs from January 1 – December 31 each year. Your first section is FREE; each additional section is \$15. Section membership provides professional growth and development through: monthly meetings, Continuing Legal Education programs, a monthly newsletter, review of legislative and court actions, and e-mail list serves. Section meetings with substantive topics are approved for one CLE credit.
