

	FIELD	ALASKA CASE LAW DATABASE (AK-CS) or (AK)
CO	COURT	An abbreviation for the court of decision. Co(high) = Alaska Supreme Court Co(low) = Court of Appeals
SY	SYNOPSIS	A summary of the case prepared by West, a Thomson business, another publisher, or the court. The BG and HG fields, when available, are part of this field.
BG	BACKGROUND	A summary of the nature of the case and party designations. This field, when available, is included in the SYNOPSIS field.
HG	HOLDING	Summary of the major holdings in the case. This field, when available, is included in the SYNOPSIS field.
WP	WORDS-PHRASES	Legal terms and phrases defined within headnotes. This field is based on West's Words and Phrases publication.
DI	DIGEST	Combined TOPIC and HEADNOTE fields.
TO	TOPIC	West editorial classifications, including the number and title of Digest topics and Key Number information.
HE	HEADNOTE	Editorial descriptions of legal rules and principles discussed in the case. E.g., to retrieve headnotes referencing Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 308, use HE(308) in TX-CS.
JU	JUDGE	Name of the judge writing the principal opinion.
AT	ATTORNEY	Names of counsel.
FT	FULL-TEXT	All info except what's in synopsis and digest fields.
OP	OPINONS	Opinions and the names of judges.
LE	LEAD	Text of lead opinions, which includes majority and plurality opinions and opinions by equally-divided courts. E.g., use LE(Kennedy & abortion) in SCT.
CON	CONCURRING	Text of concurring opinions or opinions that concur in part and dissent in part and the judges who wrote the opinions. E.g., use CON(Stevens & abortion) in SCT.
DIS	DISSENTING	Text of dissenting opinions or opinions that concur in part and dissent in part and the judges who wrote the opinions. E.g., use DIS(Marshall & abortion) in SCT.
PR	PRELIM	Includes West's or other publisher's editorial notes 1984 use PR(rehearing /s november /s 1984).
NO	NOTES	West's or other publisher's editorial notes. no(unpublished) = MOJ
DN	DOCKET-NUMBER	Docket number(s) assigned to the case.
PA	PANEL	List of judges participating in the decision,
TI	TITLE	Formal name of a case and a complete description of all adverse parties.
CI	CITATION	Unique references for citing to a specific case.
